Catchbox is a throwable microphone designed for audience engagement during live events, such as conferences, panel discussions, and lectures. It is essentially a soft cube-shaped microphone that can be tossed from person to person in the audience, allowing them to ask questions and make comments without the need for passing around a traditional microphone or standing up and walking to a stationary microphone.

Catchbox is a wireless microphone that connects to the sound system using a receiver, which can be plugged into a mixing board or speaker system. It is equipped with an automatic muting system that turns off the microphone when it is caught or thrown, which helps to prevent unwanted noise and feedback.

Catchbox is popular with event organizers and speakers because it encourages audience participation and makes Q&A sessions more interactive and fun. It also saves time and eliminates the need for a dedicated microphone runner or multiple stationary microphones.
